REGIS' TOP STEPS TO ENROLLMENT SUCCESS

01. REMEMBER YOU'RE NOT IN THIS ALONE.

You now have a **Success Team** comprised of your Admissions Counselor, your New Student Coach and your Academic Success Coach. We all work together to ensure you are set up for success at Regis! Your Admissions Counselor and Onboarding Coach are here to guide you through the initial steps in starting this journey with us.

02. TRANSCRIPTS, STAT!

If you have not already submitted your official transcripts, don't delay! Official transcripts are needed prior to meeting with your Student Success Coach.

03. SET YOURSELF UP FOR REGIS.

To register for classes, access your schedule and course syllabi, make payments and more, you'll need to activate your **RegisNet** account and Regis email address. This will become your username and password for all things Regis, so it's important to get set up as soon as possible:

To do so:

- Go to **portal.office.com**
- Enter your RegisNet email address. Your RegisNet email address is {RegisNet Account ID(Regarding (Contact))}@regis.edu
- For the password, you will enter a formula:
YYYYStudentNNNN
 - YYYY = your birth year
 - Type the word: Student
 - NNNN = the last 4 digits of your social security number

If you have any issues, please contact ITS for assistance at **303.458.4050**.

Please note: If you do not have a social security number, you should use your Regis ID in place of the last 4 digits (for example: 1984Student1234567). You can access your Regis email in two locations: **rumail.regis.edu** and **office.com**.

04. PLAN YOUR TUITION PAYMENTS.

Understand that time dedicated to school is not time spent working. To ensure your education is uninterrupted, come up with a financial plan that accommodates paying for your education and your life at the same time.

Visit **regis.edu/studentaccounts** to review information on the cost of attendance, tuition due dates, sponsored billing and all available payment options.

If you're seeking financial aid, complete the Financial Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at **fafsa.ed.gov**. List Regis University, Federal Code **001363**, in the school section of the FAFSA.

05. REGISTER FOR CLASS(ES) WHILE THERE IS STILL TIME.

Don't delay, as classes can fill up quickly. We recommend you get this done as soon as you are eligible to register. Your Admissions Counselor will help you register for your first class(es).

For future terms, you'll register for classes yourself by logging in to **webadvisor.regis.edu** under *Search and Register For Sections*.

06. GRAB YOUR BOOKS.

It is recommended to purchase your books 1-2 weeks before your classes begin. Once you've registered for classes and your financial aid is confirmed, log in to **webadvisor.regis.edu** to get your course schedule. Visit **regis.edu/bookstore** to purchase—or rent—paperback and digital texts. Waiting on a financial aid refund? Email **stuacct@regis.edu** for help.

07. SET YOURSELF UP FOR SUCCESS.

To help you prepare for your journey with us, you will be enrolled in an online New Student Orientation module. This module provides tools and resources that are critical to your overall success as a student. Your New Student Coach will coordinate your enrollment into this required orientation module, which introduces the Learning Management System, student support resource, and important how-to's for registration, accessing your student account and financial aid. We recommend that you get started on orientation before you start your first Regis class.

08. GET WORLDCLASS.

Students use the WorldClass online learning management system for many things: submitting assignments, communicating with faculty, viewing syllabi, and accessing grades. Check out WorldClass resources and online participation requirements at **regis.edu/worldclassinfo**. On the Friday prior to the start of each term, online students may access course materials at **worldclass.regis.edu** under the *Content* tab.
